He currently serves as a Research Officer (Ayurveda) at the Dr. Achanta Lakshmipathi Regional Ayurveda Research Institute (ALRARI) in Chennai, a key institution under the Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.

His career with CCRAS began in 2006. Over the years, he has held various significant positions, including Research Officer (Ayurveda) at the Central Research Institute (CRI) in Bhubaneswar, Cheruthurthy, and ALRCA Chennai. Notably, he served as the Research Officer In-charge at RARI Nagaland, where he played a crucial role in establishing the unit.
