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Dr. Bandi Venkateshwarlu is currently working as **Assistant Director In charge**, at Regional Ayurveda Research institute (under the Central Council for Research in **Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS)**, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, New Delhi), Vijayawada. His roles and responsibilities mainly include entire Administrative and Technical activities pertaining to the Regional Ayurveda Research institute, Vijayawada as Institute In charge. He completed his B.A.M.S. & MD (Ayurveda-Dravyaguna) from NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh. Further, he studied PG Diploma in Chemical Analysis and Quality Management (PGDCAQM) from University of Hyderabad (Central University), Hyderabad. He started his career as Senior Research Fellow (Ayurveda) in CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Technology, Hyderabad in the year 2002 under NMITLI project. He worked as Research and Medical Officer and Production In charge from 2003-2005 in a GMP certified reputed Ayurvedic Pharmacy at Vijayawada. He further served from May 2005 to 31 December 2005 as Scientific Officer (Ayurveda) in A. P. State Level Drug Testing Laboratory, Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad.

He joined in Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Ministry of Ayush in the year 2006, as Research Officer (Ayurveda) at Central Research Institute (Ayurveda), Gwalior. He has served as Assistant Director/Research Officer (Ayurveda) at various peripheral institutes & HQ of CCRAS i.e, CCRAS HQ, New Delhi, NIIMH-Hyderabad, NARIP - Cheruthuruthy, RARI-Vijayawada, CARI-Guwahati and RARI-Itanagar.
